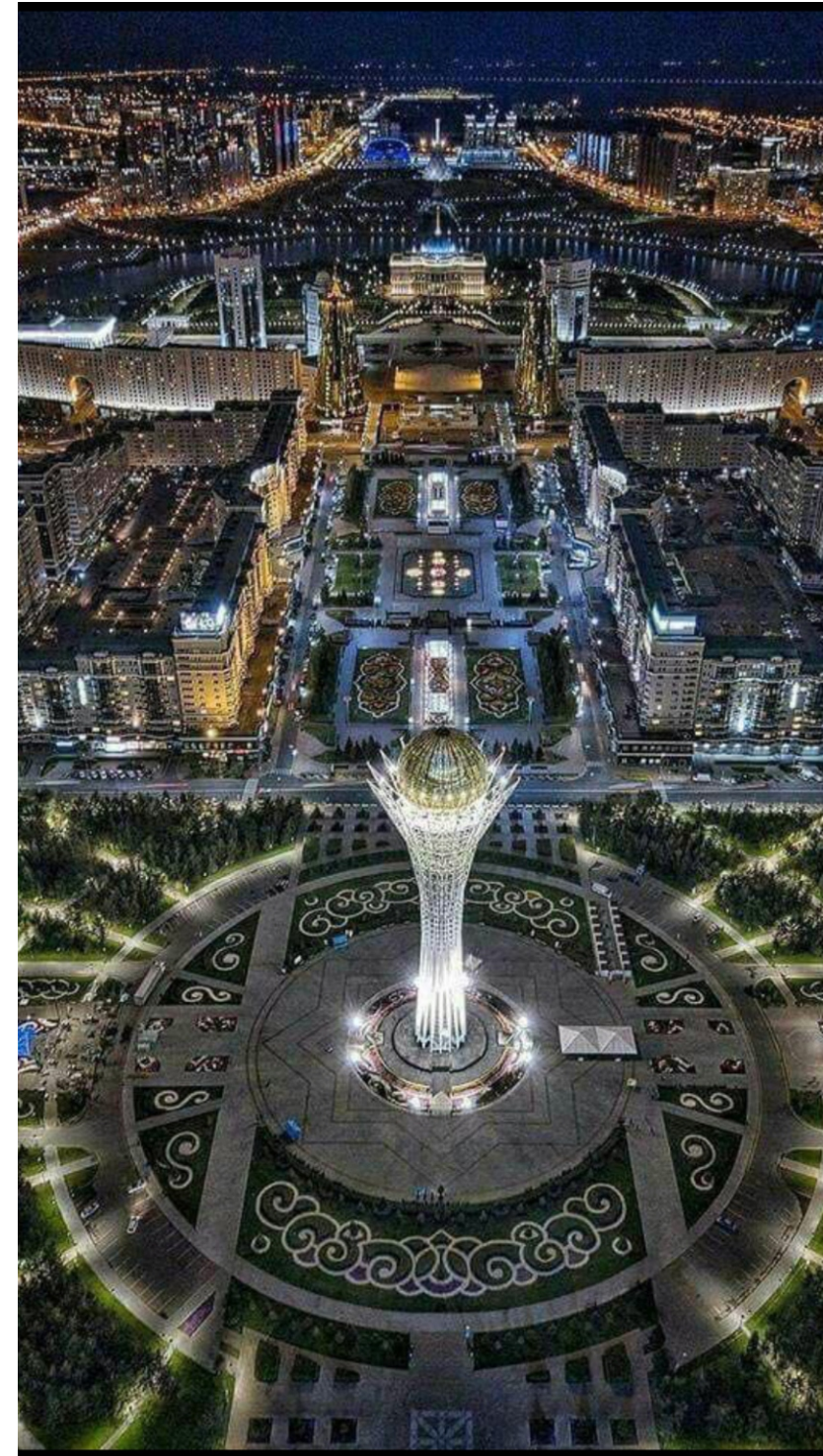

RULES AND REGULATIONS

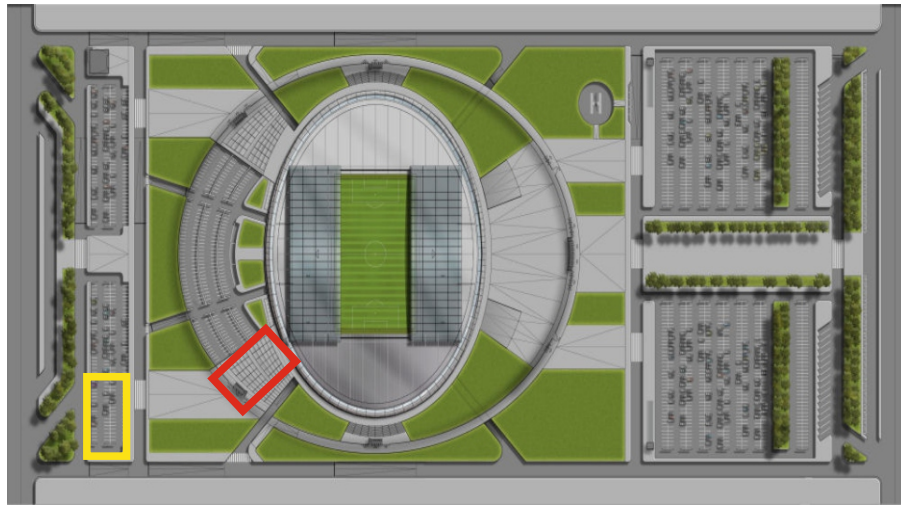
To ensure that all guests have a safe and enjoyable visit to Astana-Arena Stadium, guests will not be permitted to bring the following items into the stadium:

- ONLY CLEAR BAGS SMALLER THAN 12x12x6 WILL BE PERMITTED, OR SMALL CLUTCH PURSE SMALLER THAN 4 1/2 X 6 1/2 INCHES. This includes all purses, briefcases, binocular cases, backpacks, fanny packs, cinch bags, luggage of any kind, computer or camera bags, or any bag larger than the permissible size and guidelines.




- All Coolers (unless medically required)
- Illegal substances
- Noisemakers
- Obscene or indecent clothing
- Recording equipment
- Segways/motorized scooters, mobility devices are allowed
- Sticks, bats, poles or club
- Strollers
- Thermal containers
- Photo cameras with lens that exceed 6 inches
- Video cameras
- Weapons
- Remote controlled aircrafts, drones
- Beverage containers
- Bottles and cans, with the exception of unopen bottled water
- Alcoholic beverages
- Animals (with the exception of service animals)

Business working hours

Usual business working hours in Kazakhstan are from 9.00 till 18.00 with a lunch break between 13.00 and 14.00, Shops in Astana are usually open till 8-10 pm and some supermarkets work 24 hours.

Money

Kazakh national currency is Tenge (KZT). US Dollars, Euro and other major currencies can be easily exchanged to Tenge and back in official exchange bureaus and banks.

It is advisable to keep all documents for money exchange until departure from Kazakhstan. The majority of European and international credit and debit cards, including Visa, Master Card, Euro Card are accepted in most hotels, large shops and restaurants of Astana.

Communication

Mobile phone network coverage is available all over Kazakhstan, though in remote areas the coverage might be limited. Internet access: free Wi-Fi is available in airports and railway stations of major cities. In addition, internet cafes are widely available in cities of Kazakhstan.

Local Calls

If you are calling locally how you dial will depend on whether you are using a land line or a cellular phone.

If you are calling a land line from a land line, it is easy. Simply dial the local number (last six digits).

If you are calling a land line from a cell phone, you must dial the prefix: 8 + the city code (7172 for Astana) and then the local number.

If you are calling a cell phone from a land line or another cell phone, you must also dial the prefix: 8 + the cell company code + the number

Electric power points

Electrical current in Kazakhstan is 220 volts, AC 50Hz. Two-pin power sockets are used, mainly compatible with both German 'Schuko' and Europlugs.
